FATIMA

(80 min.) THE ULTIMATE MYSTERY

Has the secret of Fatima changed the course of history? This documentary film investigates, starting from the apparitions of Our Lady in 1917, a chain of strange coincidences that relate the secret of Fatima with inexplicable historical changes.

What did Fatima have to do with Lenin's communist revolution and with the two World Wars? Why was the Third one avoided? Why was John Paul II not killed? Did Fatima influence the collapse of the Soviet Empire? Why is Fatima an Arabic name? This film, with recreations, scenes of fiction, and opinions of experts, gives us the keys to the past... and to the future.






(88 min.) FAUSTINA THE APOSTOL OF DIVINE MERCY

It tells the story of her mystical experiences as a nun living in a convent in Poland in the early 20th century. It is to her that Jesus appeared and commanded that she be his instrument for promoting devotion to his Divine Mercy. He also requested from Sister Faustina that an image be painted and venerated of him and his Divine Mercy, and asked that we pray especially the Chaplet of Mercy...

Highlights



Light of Soledad (107 min. + extras)

Olga is an only daughter and she must take care of her father, Mr. Arturo, an irascible man of a hard character who suffers from illness. Exhausted by her job at the law firm, she needs someone to look after him at night and she calls the last person her father wants to see: Sister Inés, a nun, Servant of Mary.

The film narrates the beginnings of the Servants of Mary, a religious institution originated in Madrid in 1851 by inspiration of the priest Father Miguel Martinez and that Soledad Torres Acosta guided in its development and expansion until her death in 1887. These are difficult years in which Mother Soledad and her Servants of Mary are facing revolutions, epidemics and religious persecutions.



Poveda (116 min. + extras)

This biographical drama film tells the story of Pedro Poveda (1874 – 1936), a tenacious and innovative priest who opened new paths in education and pioneered the rights of women in the early twentieth century. A victim of intolerance, he was murdered at the outbreak of the Spanish Civil War. In 1974 he was awarded the title of "Educator and Humanist" by UNESCO and was canonized by Pope John Paul II in 2003.

He starts a new Christian movement, led by young women, which will become the Teresian Association. For its development he relies on young Pepita Segovia, one of the first women of her time to receive a university degree in education.



The Face of Mercy (57 min.)

Watch its story unfold, from St. Faustina's powerful visions of a merciful God, to her countryman Pope John Paul II who propelled the message of Divine Mercy onto the world stage.

Meet the woman who found freedom in forgiveness after seeing her family wiped out by genocide; the former-NFL linebacker who walked away from football to share Christ's mercy with the homeless; and the young widow who chose mercy towards her husband's killer.


Mendel THE FATHER OF THE GENETICS


The Patriach
